
## **Creating your own EU Passport**

## **Activity Form**

Time: 20/30 minutes School Level: Primary or secondary Proficiency Level: A1 – C2 Interaction: Individual, pairs, small groups, entire class Method: Form filling and creativity Content: Passport (official document) Material: Handout #2.3



## Instructions:

- 1. **Preparation**: Assign each individual student handout #2.3.
- 2. **Personal information fill in**. Ask students to fill in their personal information i.e., name, date of birth, place of birth, nationality, date of issue, and to sign their name.
- 3. **Creativity**. Ask students to draw a picture of themselves next to personal information and color in their work passport with colored pencils, crayons, and/or markers.
- 4. Writing in words for countries or places. Ask Students to write in the names of countries they've already visited in Europe or would like to visit. Should be done in English.
- 5. **Sharing**. The sharing of passports can take place in pairs or small groups or as an entire class.
